ROADS IN THE LANDSCAPE

The relationships between the landscape and roads have been approached traditionally from the perspective of the integration of roads into the landscape. This is a highly relevant factor, but not the only one. The seminar aims to deal with a whole array of aspects of the road/landscape relationship that are not always fully taken into account. One of such aspects deals, for instance, with the high heritage value of many roads (in particular country roads) and their contribution throughout history in organising and shaping the territory. Considering their status as a massive form of access to knowledge about the territory, roads have an enormous educational potential. And last, but not least, they highlight the diversity of landscapes in the country, and generate highly diverse tourist and leisure experiences.
